- **Measure:** Purchase undeveloped land in the 65 DNL southeast of the airport.
Status: The TAA has purchased over 3000 acres of land surrounding the airport for land use compatibility purposes.
- **Measure:** Offer avigation easements for homes not suitable to sound insulation or owner does not want sound insulation.
Status: TAA will work with homeowners to secure easements where applicable.
- **Measure:** Implement a residential sales assistance program for homes in the 70 DNL.
Status: In lieu of this program, homes within the 70 DNL were incorporated into the Sound Insulation Program.
- **Measure:** Acquire mobile homes in the 70 DNL and redevelop the land for compatible private use.
Status: Acquisition was pursued however the mobile home park owner was not willing to sell the land.
- **Measure:** Maintain present noise compatibility staff to assist in addressing noise issues and mitigation implementation.
Status: The TAA currently has positions responsible for managing the Residential Sound Insulation Program; staff from the Public Information and Planning Departments oversee implementation of mitigation and abatement measures.
- **Measure:** Form an advisory committee to assist TAA to implement noise abatement and mitigation programs on an 'as needed' basis.
Status: An advisory committee was formed to meet on an as needed basis.
